Friday	1 <sup>st</sup> May	Departure We recommend to take advantage of the public holiday and visit the beautiful East Frisian island Langeoog!


If you cannot come to Germany, we would be very happy if you pass on this message within your institution and encourage the staff to come and visit us in April.
